

Level: Beginner


Requirements: Anyone interested can join the course.

the Course Approach

A MOOC is delivered on-line. The lectures are videos and reading materials, which are available 24/7. Take the course at your own pace, and interact with other students (and the trainers) through the forum. There are no late night calls, and you don't have to travel! Each week you will be able to interact with highly experienced experts in 1-hour live webinars, but don't worry – if you miss them, you will be able to watch them afterwards. Each week, up to three lessons will be released. Each lesson contains the video materials to watch, homework for you to work on, and a quiz to assess your learning.
